The map on this flyer shows the attendance boundaries being recommended to the Clark County School District Board of School Trustees. This recommendation has been reviewed with the Superintendent and will be presented to the Board for their discussion and action on February 25, 2019. The Board of School Trustees recognizes that zoning issues affect the lives of students and families in the district.

This meeting is a public meeting. However, public testimony may be restricted by time constraints; parents may want to select other methods to voice their opinions. Board members encourage parents to communicate their support and/or concerns regarding the boundary changes recommended by AZAC by the following methods:

Select a designated speaker to represent a group of people with like opinions. Time allotted to each speaker will be determined by the Board; speakers are usually given one or two minutes, depending on how many individuals have signed up to speak.

All middle and junior high school boundary changes will be effective in the 2019-2020 school year.

El mapa en este folleto señala los límites de zona que se le han recomendado a la Mesa Directiva del Distrito Escolar. 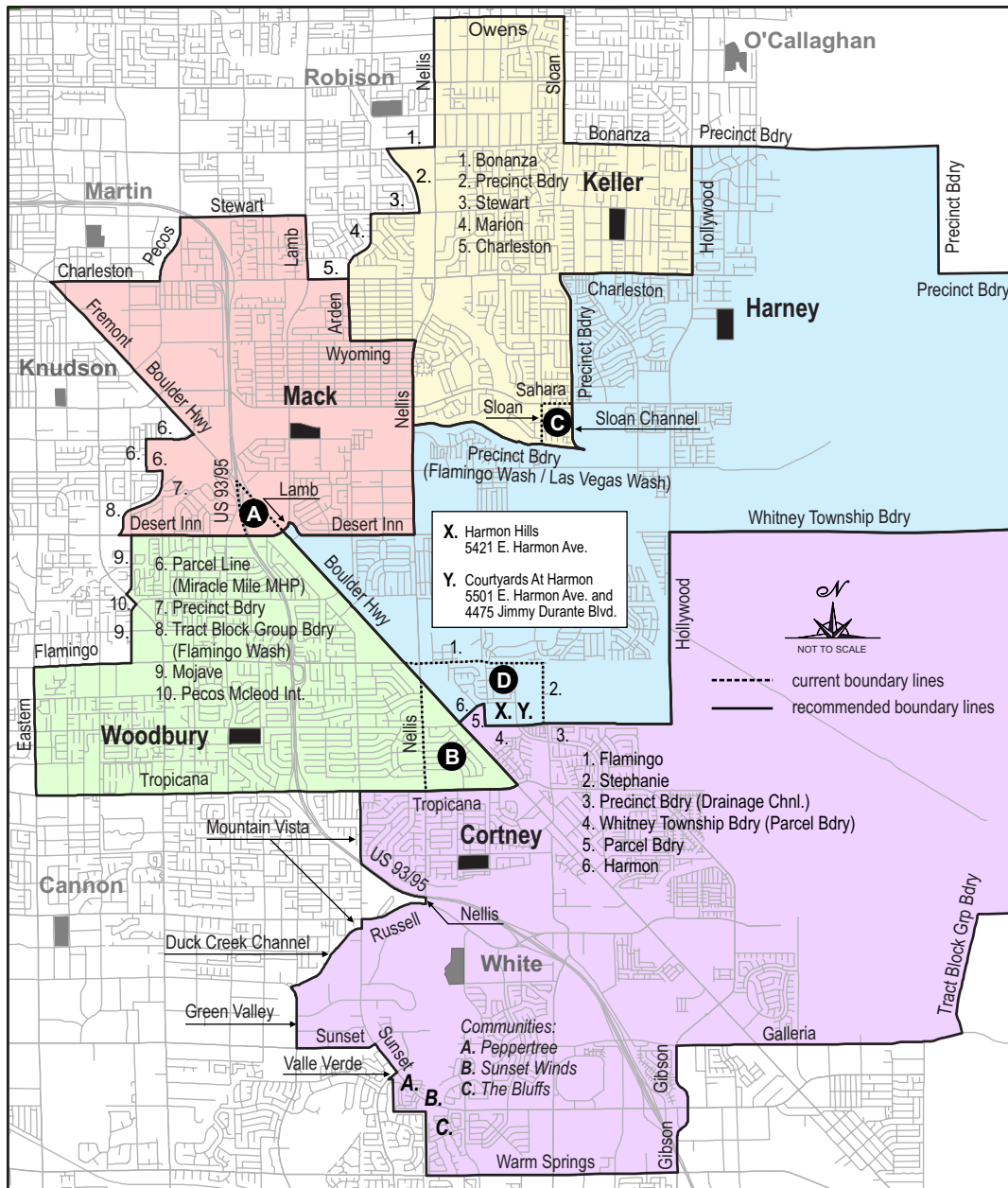

Recommended Phasing Program

The recommended attendance boundary change will occur in phases, by reassigning one grade level each year until all grades, 6-8, have been reassigned. Beginning with the 6th grade phasing will be implemented at the start of the 2019-2020 school year.

An option for older siblings to attend their younger siblings' designated school is provided, with transportation, if eligible as indicated in Policy and Regulation 3531.

Future annual assessments of the area demographics will be conducted and may result in canceling phasing program by implementing the entire attendance boundary adjustment, as approved, at once.
