Attendance Boundary Recommendation

Recommendation will affect the existing attendance boundaries of Duane D. Keller Junior High School, and Dr. William H. "Bob" Bailey, Jim Bridger, Jerome D. Mack, Roy W. Martin, Mario C. and JoAnne Monaco, Dell H. Robison, J. D. Smith, and Ed Von Tobel Middle Schools.

The map on this flyer shows the attendance boundaries being recommended to the Clark County School District Board of School Trustees. This recommendation has been reviewed with the Superintendent and will be presented to the Board for their discussion and action on March 2, 2020. The Board of School Trustees recognizes that zoning issues affect the lives of students and families in the district.

This meeting is a public meeting. However, public testimony may be restricted by time constraints; parents may want to select other methods to voice their opinions. Board members encourage parents to communicate their support and/or concerns regarding the boundary changes recommended by AZAC by the following methods:

Select a designated speaker to represent a group of people with like opinions. Time allotted to each speaker will be determined by the Board; speakers are usually given one or two minutes, depending on how many individuals have signed up to speak.

Implementation of middle and junior high school boundaries (grades 6-8):

All middle and junior high school boundary changes will be effective in the 2020-2021 school year.

El mapa en este folleto señala los límites de zona que se le han recomendado a la Mesa Directiva del Distrito Escolar. Las recomendaciones ya se han revisado con el Superintendente y serán presentadas a la Mesa Directiva para discutir y tomar decisiones finales, el 2 de marzo del 2020. 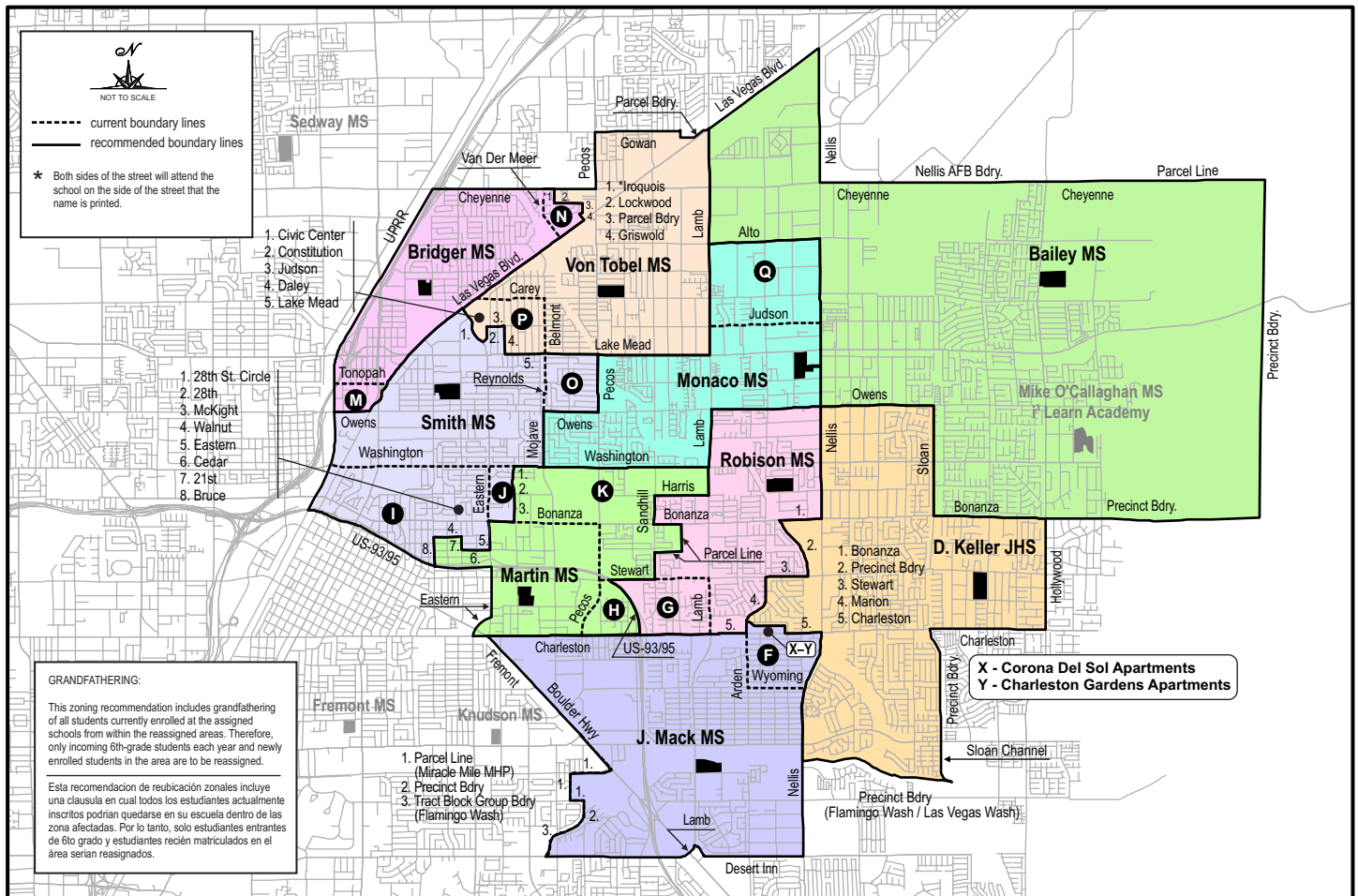
