## Attendance Boundary Recommendation

*Recommendation will establish an attendance boundary for the new Shirley A. Barber and Robert and Sandy Ellis Elementary Schools and affect the existing attendance boundaries of John C. Bass, Roberta Curry Cartwright, Roger D. Gehring, John R. Hummel, Steve Schorr, and Shirley and Bill Wallin Elementary Schools.*

The map on this flyer shows the attendance boundaries being recommended to the Clark County School District Board of School Trustees. This recommendation has been reviewed with the Superintendent and will be presented to the Board for their discussion and action on February 21, 2018. The Board of School Trustees recognizes that zoning issues affect the lives of students and families in the district.

This meeting is a public meeting. However, public testimony may be restricted by time constraints; parents may want to select other methods to voice their opinions. Board members encourage parents to communicate their support and/or concerns regarding the boundary changes recommended by AZAC by the following methods:

Select a designated speaker to represent a group of people with like opinions. Time allotted to each speaker will be determined by the Board; speakers are usually given one or two minutes, depending on how many individuals have signed up to speak.

All elementary school boundary changes will be effective in the 2018-2019 school year.

El mapa en este folleto señala los límites de zona que se le han recomendado a la Mesa Directiva del Distrito Escolar. 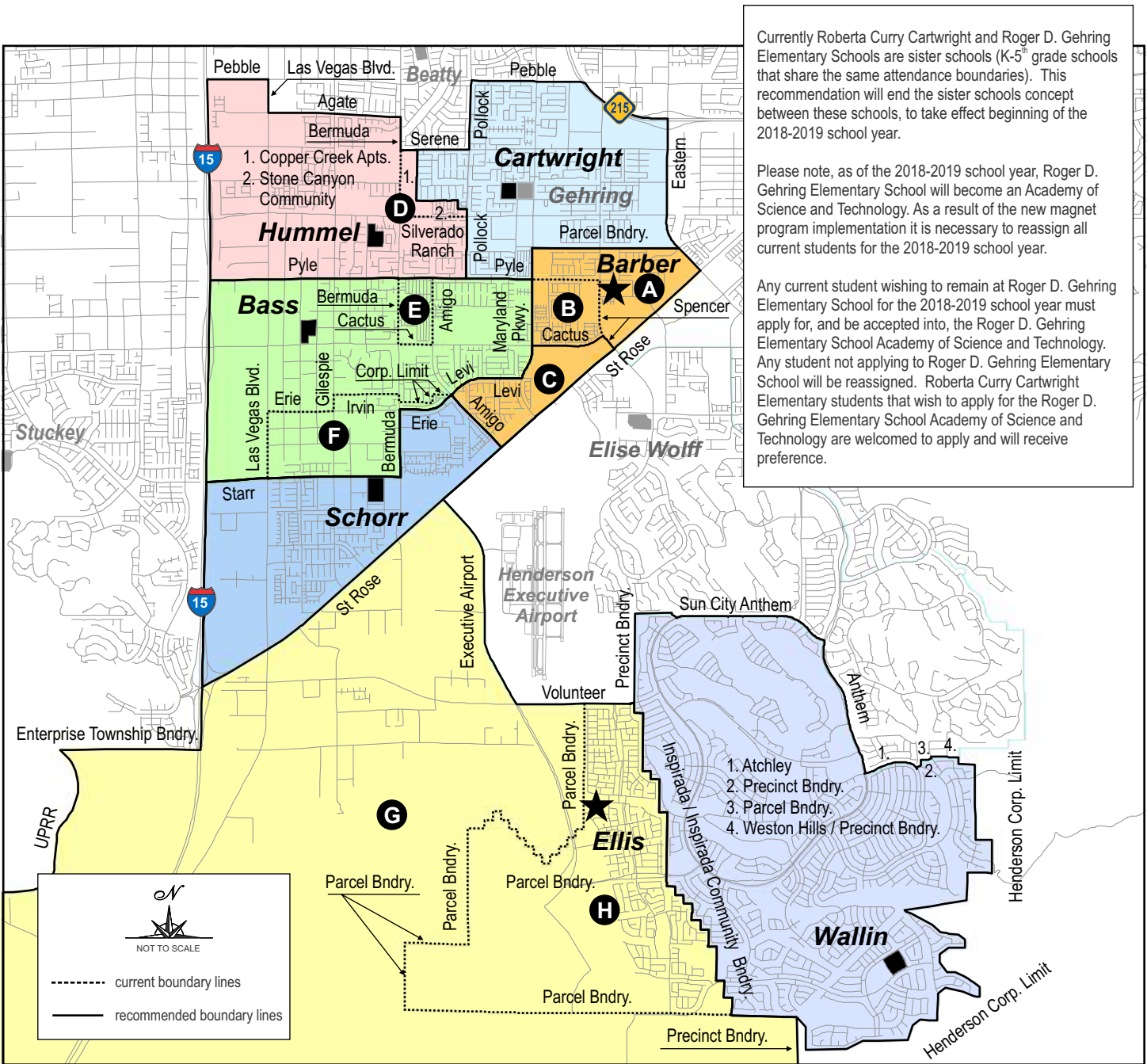

# AZAC Recommended Changes to Elementary School Attendance Boundaries for 2018-2019 School Year



Currently Roberta Curry Cartwright and Roger D. Gehring Elementary Schools are sister schools (K-5<sup>th</sup> grade schools that share the same attendance boundaries). This recommendation will end the sister schools concept between these schools, to take effect beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.

Please note, as of the 2018-2019 school year, Roger D. Gehring Elementary School will become an Academy of Science and Technology. As a result of the new magnet program implementation it is necessary to reassign all current students for the 2018-2019 school year.

Any current student wishing to remain at Roger D. Gehring Elementary School for the 2018-2019 school year must apply for, and be accepted into, the Roger D. Gehring Elementary School Academy of Science and Technology. Any student not applying to Roger D. Gehring Elementary School will be reassigned. Roberta Curry Cartwright Elementary students that wish to apply for the Roger D. Gehring Elementary School Academy of Science and Technology are welcomed to apply and will receive preference.
