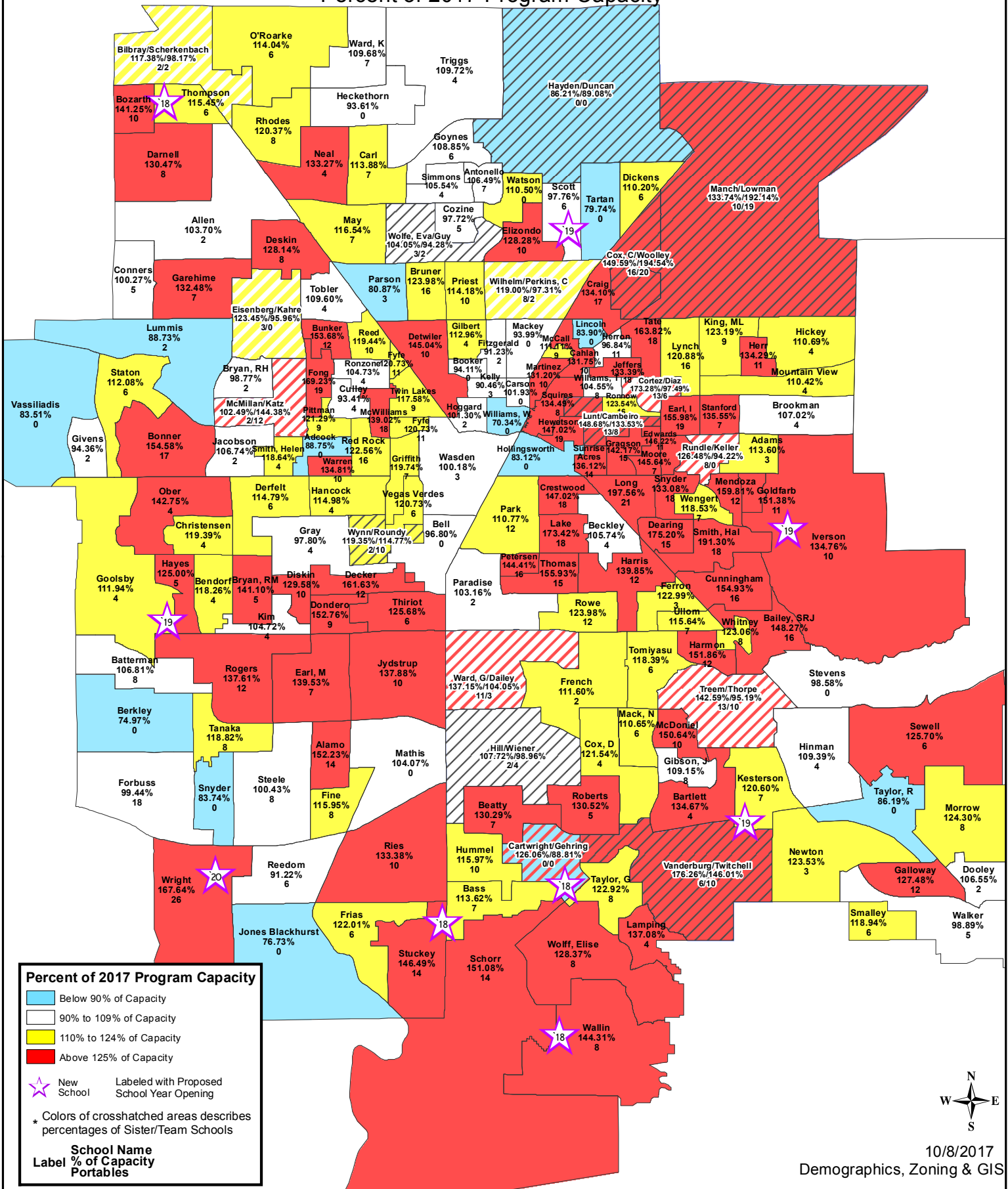


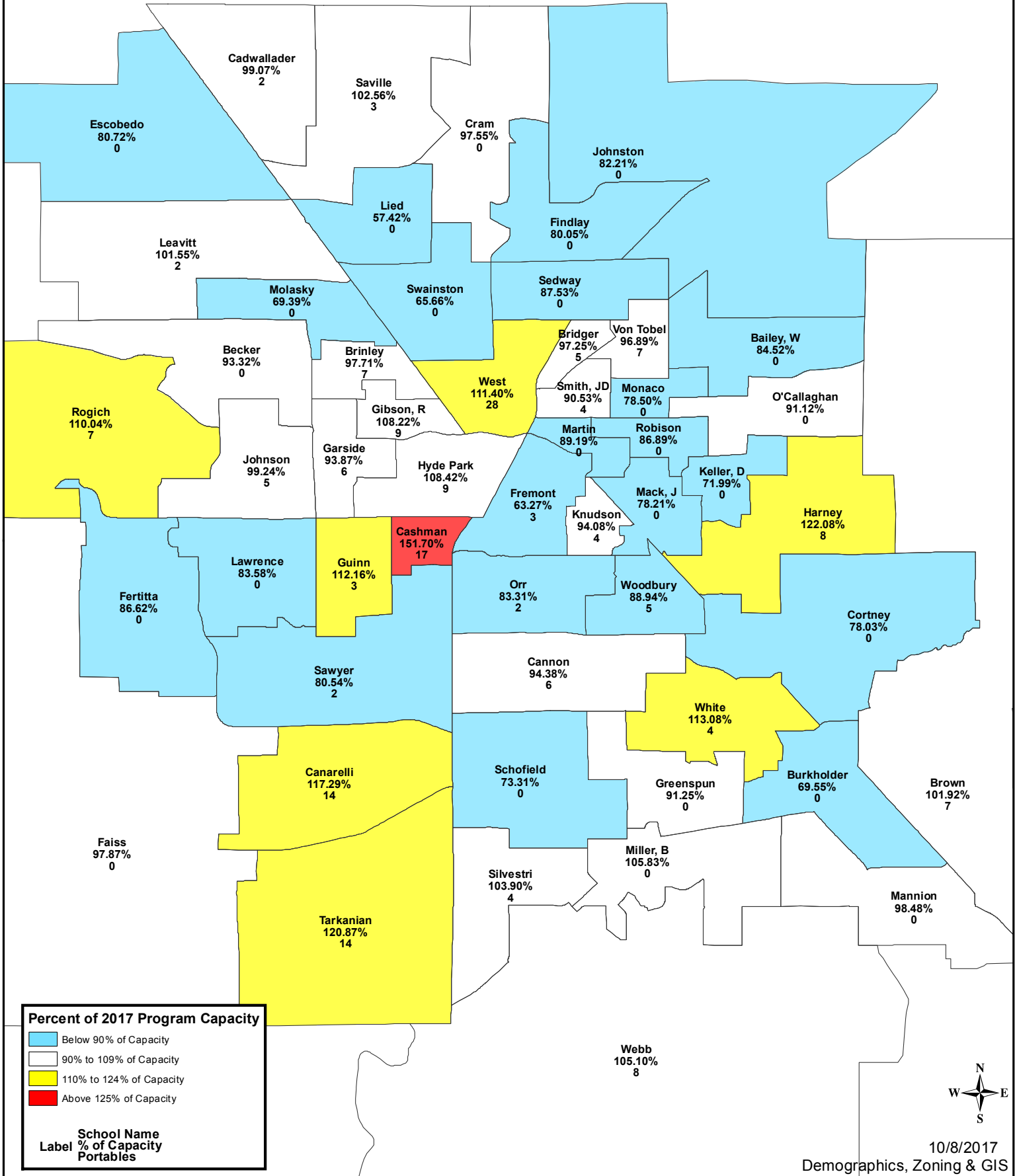

2017 Elementary School Enrollment With State Excluded Pre-K Students Percent of 2017 Program Capacity



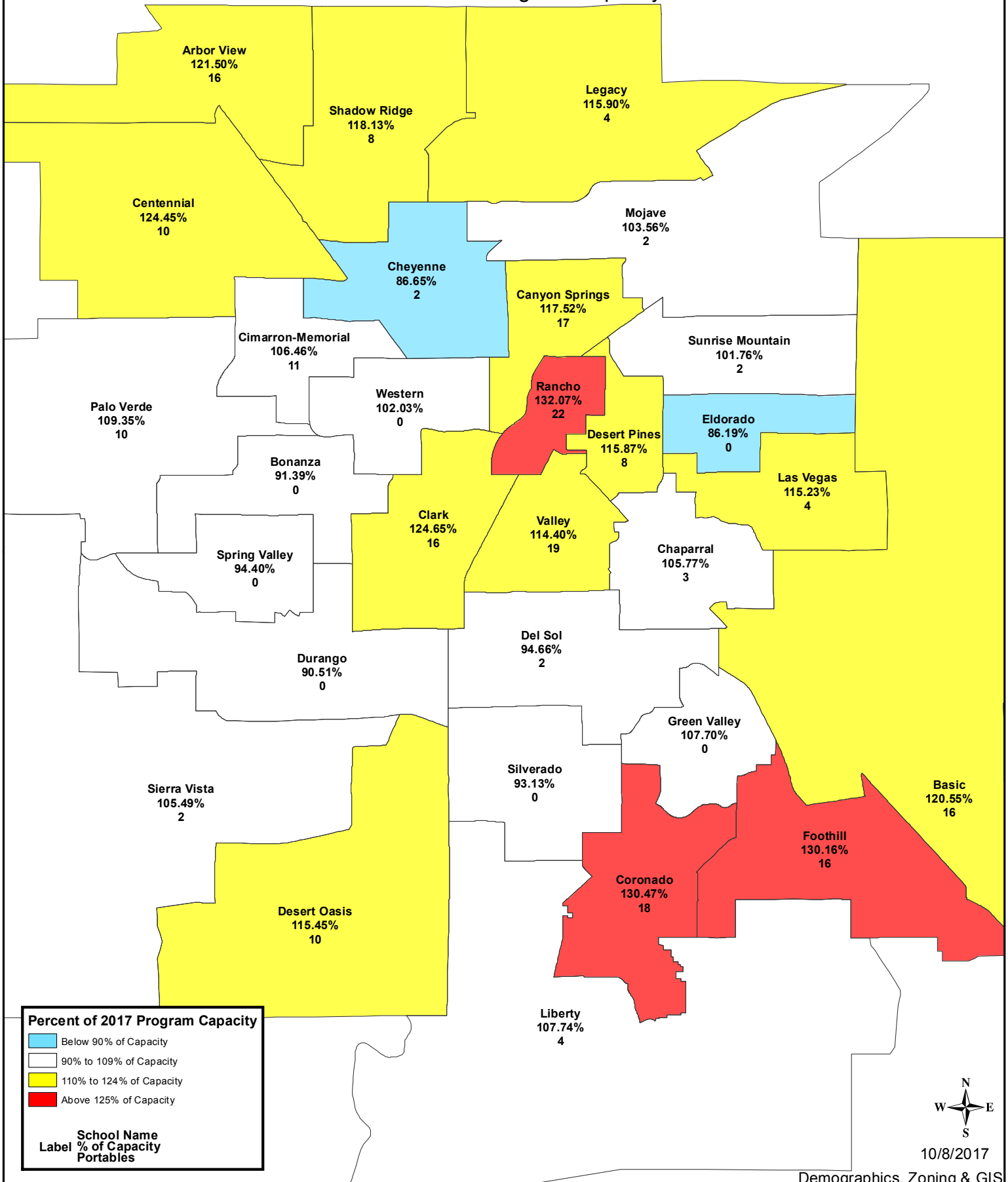
