FLAG SALUTE

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

A motion was made to adopt the agenda as is.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

REPORTS

Rick Baldwin explained the contents of the packets given to AZAC.

REVIEW OF PUBLIC INPUT

Zan Hyer reported the parent concerns from the meeting held at Ronnow Elementary School were that of whether the children would still be able to walk to school.

Erin Cranor stated another concern was that the population in the area felt they were better served on the year-round calendar and they wished to remain on a year-round calendar.

A motion was made to take focus area E3, proposal B as amended, to have the area south of Judson Avenue, west of Marion Drive, east of Lamb Boulevard, and north of Lake Mead Boulevard remain at Lynch Elementary School to the Board of School Trustees for Cortez, Diaz, Ira J. Earl, Lynch, Ronnow, and Tate Elementary Schools.

Gaya Guymon, Kitty Kinkade, and Patricia Lopez were not present to vote.

There was discussion about the capacity of Red Rock Elementary School and whether they could handle receiving additional students in order to provide relief to Culley Elementary School.

Dave Miller said at the public input meeting there was overwhelming support from the staff of Culley Elementary School to provide them with relief.

A motion was made to take focus area E7, proposal A, as a recommendation to the Board of School Trustees for Culley and Red Rock Elementary Schools.

The proposals for focus area E1 were reviewed.

Ken Rezendes said the density surrounding Thompson Elementary School is very high; he said the school scheduled to be built in Providence will provide relief to Thompson Elementary School.

A motion was made to take focus area E1, proposal A as amended, to include the area east of El Capitan Way, north of Meisenheimer Avenue, west of Durango Drive, and south of Brent Lane to attend O'Roarke Elementary School; and the Sun Crest community to remain at Bilbray and Scherkenbach Elementary Schools, to the Board of School Trustees for Allen, Bilbray, O'Roarke, Scherkenbach, and Thompson Elementary Schools.

Sharon Dattoli explained after looking at the data, staff cannot consider the phase up option at the middle school level.

Dave Miller said AZAC should not be involved with the decisions to phase up; he said the Board of School Trustees should make the policies in regards to the phase up option.

The proposals for focus area M1 were reviewed.

Sharon Dattoli said that a combination of the two proposals was developed. Discussion followed.

Ken Rezendes expressed his concerns with proposal A because it affects a large amount of students.

A motion was made to take focus area M1, proposal A as amended, to include both sides of Sheila Avenue to attend Brinley Middle School; and to have the area south of Lake Mead Boulevard, west of Decatur Boulevard, north of Vegas Drive, east of Saylor Way, north of Carl Avenue, east of the Precinct Boundary to Lake Mead Boulevard to remain at Gibson Middle School; and no change for Johnson Junior High School, to the Board of School Trustees for Becker, Brinley, Gibson, Molasky, and Rogich Middle/Junior High Schools.

Becky Nielson called for a recess at 11:34 am.

The meeting reconvened at 11:43 am.

Gaya Guymon said from the comments given at the public input meeting, most people preferred proposal C of focus area E2. Ms. Guymon said she thought Centennial Parkway was a good boundary line. Ms. Guymon discussed the potential growth in the area, particularly in the Dickens and Tartan Elementary School boundaries.

A motion was made to take focus area E2, proposal C as amended, to remove Dickens Elementary School from the proposal, and for the area south of CC-215, west of Pecos Road, north of Centennial Parkway, and east of Losee Road to remain at Tartan Elementary School, to the Board of School Trustees for Elizondo, Hayden, Scott, and Tartan Elementary Schools.
