REPORTS

Rick Baldwin informed AZAC their informational packet includes the approved zoning for elementary and secondary as well as the AZAC Priorities and Procedures for the 2007-08 school year.

2007-2008 ZONING SEASON

Buffy Kilarski asked what schools the new Diaz Elementary School would be giving relief to.

Rick Baldwin stated Diaz Elementary School could possibly provide relief to Lynch, Cortez, and surrounding Elementary Schools.

Buffy Kilarski stated since there is growth within the Harney, Keller, and Cortney Middle/Junior High School zones with no middle schools being sited for a few years, the area should be evaluated and added to Item C on AZAC's Priorities and Procedures for the 2007-08 school year. Mrs. Kilarski also suggested that staff work with Real Property Management to site schools in the east bench.

Rick Baldwin stated it is anticipated the East Career and Technical Academy will provide relief to Rancho, Eldorado, and Desert Pines High Schools.

Becky Nielson asked for an evaluation of the high rise development in District D next year and how many students those projects will be yielding.

Gaya Guymon asked that the Mount Charleston and Kyle Canyon area be evaluated.

Sharon Dattoli reported there are seven elementary schools left to site: four in 2009 and three in 2010.

Gaya Guymon said the Centennial High School zone should be evaluated as they will be getting crowded as well.

Sharon Dattoli said that the Northwest Career and Technical Academy should provide relief to Centennial High School. Ms. Dattoli assured AZAC the areas being requested would be evaluated as each year a hot spot map is prepared for them.

Rick Baldwin reported several students from Centennial and Palo Verde High Schools have applied to the Northwest Career and Technical Academy (NWCTA). Mr. Baldwin stated the NWCTA opens with only 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades and once there is full implementation it will provide an even greater amount of relief. Mr. Baldwin also stated that all Career and Technical Academies are projected to be opened by 2009.

There was discussion on how full-day kindergarten, sister schools, and choice schools are determined.

Buffy Kilarski thanked everyone and said she would not be returning as an AZAC member.

#### PUBLIC HEARINGS

Erin Cranor called for public input.

Carolyn Edwards, Board of School Trustees, District F thanked AZAC and staff for all their hard work this season.

Ken Rezendes stated it has been the greatest two years in community service for him and thanked everyone for their assistance and service, as he too will not be returning.
