REPORTS

Rick Baldwin explained the contents of the packets given to AZAC.

APPROVED ZONING FOR THE 2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR

Rick Baldwin reviewed zoning for the 2012-2013 school year as approved by the Board of School Trustees on February 28, 2012. Mr. Baldwin said the Board took no action on the recommendation for Greenspun, Schofield, Silvestri, Webb, and White Junior High/Middle Schools; the Board of School Trustees will further discuss the item on the March 22, 2012 Board meeting.

THE 2012-2013 ZONING SEASON

Rick Baldwin said staff would be diligent to include more descriptive detail on board items when phasing and/or transportation is recommended. Mr. Baldwin said he would like to have discussion with Administration as to whether they want to have a more appropriate feeder alignment within Performance Zones than already is in place.

Rick Baldwin explained the Performance Zone structure to AZAC.

Anna Slighting said she would like to have a clearer definition of the Superintendent's perspective on School Choice on next year's agenda.

JoAnne Foutz said it appears that parents attend public input meetings for more information rather than to voice their opinions and she would like to see it changed to be able to have some of their basic questions answered.

Rick Baldwin thinks most people need more of a one on one conversation as opposed to speaking in front of a large group. Mr. Baldwin said it is beneficial for staff and AZAC representatives to attend school PTA meetings to provide additional information prior to a public input meeting.

Cyndy Mahoney would not like to have AZAC meetings scheduled the day after a public input meeting.

Rick Baldwin said due to all the changes within the school district, currently there are no priorities for the next school year. Mr. Baldwin said a group is being put together to review nine month and year round calendars and he hopes to have answers by the time AZAC convenes.
