REPORT ON THE 2014-2015 ELEMENTARY CAPACITIES

Rick Baldwin reviewed the 2014-2015 Elementary School Capacity Report.

PRESENTATION OF HOT SPOT DATA FOR 2014-2015 ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Rick Baldwin explained the Elementary Hot Spot data.

Natalie Carter asked if Givens, Bonner, and Staton Elementary School boundaries can be evaluated again since they were last year.

Rick Baldwin stated they can evaluate, but may not move students in consecutive years.

Anna Slighting asked how room additions being built will alter schools' capacities.

Rick Baldwin stated that we will not know until we are advised how many rooms each addition has; the information will be shared as soon as it is available.

Albert Delgado called for public input.

PRESENTATION OF NEW RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT – ELEMENTARY

Sheri Garbiso, Senior GIS Analyst, presented information on new residential developments and their impact on elementary school enrollment.

Brian Krall questioned whether AZAC can change Snow Mountain Indian Reservation zoning if it is not located in a trustee district.

Rick Baldwin stated Snow Mountain Indian Reservation is located in District E.

Brian Krall said school growth mid-year not only makes space an issue, but creates a shortage of teachers. He asked whom he calls as a parent to recommend mid-year hiring of additional teachers.

Rick Baldwin directed him to his trustee.

Becky Nielson appreciates not having to drive around checking developments as they have in the past and thanked Mrs. Garbiso for her work.

REPORT ON THE 2014-2015 SECONDARY CAPACITIES

Rick Baldwin reviewed the 2014-2015 Secondary School Capacity Report.

Cyndy Mahoney asked Mr. Baldwin to remind the commission which middle schools are gaining magnet programs.

Rick Baldwin responded that Johnson Junior High School will have an International Baccalaureate program in 2015, Guinn Middle School will have a STEM program (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math), White Middle School will have a Performing Arts program, and in 2016 Brown Junior High School will have an IB program as well.

PRESENTATION OF HOT SPOT DATA FOR 2014-2015 SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Rick Baldwin explained the Secondary Hot Spot data.

Rick Baldwin stated that Del Sol High School will gain a Performing Arts program and Eldorado High School will have a STEM program in 2015-2016. CTE programs (Career and Technical Education) will be placed in Select Schools Silverado, Bonanza, Chaparral, Mojave, and Western High Schools. In 2016 Spring Valley and Basic High Schools will begin IB programs.

Rick Baldwin stated in order to place additional portables on the Foothill High School campus the city of Henderson requires a condition of approval. Mr. Baldwin indicated the process to request approval from the City Council and Planning Commission has begun.

Albert Delgado asked for clarification: the addition of portables to the Foothill High School campus will not affect its capacity.

Rick Baldwin said that is correct.

Albert Delgado called for public input.

Sheri Garbiso presented information on new residential developments and their impact on secondary school enrollment.
