PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Sheri Wilson, parent, Vassiliadis Elementary School and Rogich Middle School, stated she is concerned about overcrowding at these schools while surrounding schools have more space available.

Katie Baird, Allerton Park resident, stated concern about possible rezoning of Rogich Middle School and Palo Verde High School, citing distance, major streets to be crossed, the number of zone variances being granted at overcrowded schools, and inconvenient transportation scheduling.

Gina Kurcz, parent of three students at Vassiliadis Elementary School, is concerned about the overcrowding at Rogich Middle School.

Michelle Sullo, parent of two students at Rogich Middle School, is concerned about overcrowding at Rogich Middle School and Palo Verde High School. Ms. Sullo stated her students do not have time to go to their locker, which must be shared because there are not enough for all students, between classes and must carry everything in their backpacks. Ms. Sullo stated disapproval of zone variances granted at crowded schools.
