EVALUATE SCENARIO(S) FOR FOCUS AREA E1 FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

Rick Baldwin presented Scenario 1 for Focus Area E1 to establish an attendance boundary for the new elementary school at El Capitan Way and Mountains Edge Parkway opening 2020 and evaluate the existing attendance boundary of William V. Wright Elementary School.

Albert Delgado explained the scenario.

Sheri Garbiso reviewed the Development Tracking within the current Wright Elementary School's attendance boundary.

Rick Baldwin stated he and Albert Delgado had met with Wright Elementary School administrators.

Albert Delgado stated he has concerns with Scenario 1 because it leaves Wright Elementary School a little low. He stated he is working on another scenario to bring those numbers up.

Justin Hepworth voiced his concern about the future growth in that area. He is also concerned that when looking at it, distance wise, some of that growth is closer to Wright Elementary School.

Rick Baldwin reported that CCSD's Real Property Department is currently trying to acquire land for a potential future school site in that development area.

Colleen Wilson-Pappa asked what the school district's stance is on walkable distance to schools.

Shawnique Van Allen stated that the majority of the time less than 2 miles is considered a walkable distance.

EVALUATE SCENARIO(S) FOR FOCUS AREA E2 FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

Rick Baldwin presented Scenario 1 for Focus Area E2 to evaluate Frank Lamping and Elise L. Wolff Elementary Schools attendance boundaries.
